

Tucked away on the outskirts of the town, Berisfords is one of the oldest working manufacturing businesses in Congleton, Cheshire. Founded by Charles Berisford in 1858, the Berisfords that we know today harbour the same key principles in ribbon production.

Ribbon manufacturing at Berisfords is a complete in-house process, from the design, preparation of the warps to setting up each loom by hand – Berisfords have 137 looms in their factory, each running up to 24 hours a day.

Producing up to 1 million metres of ribbon each week, with approximately 5000 individual designs, Berisfords hold a stock of 6 million metres of ribbon, ready to be printed and shipped globally at any one time.

With the facilities for dyeing and finishing, Berisfords can colour match ribbons for client packaging and fabrics or dyes – providing a truly unique and bespoke product.

For ribbons that are used in contact with food, checks are carried out to ensure no wicking or colour transfer occurs, and that the ribbon will perform for the duration of the products shelf life.

Ensuring a variety of ever-changing designs, Berisfords inhouse design team hand draw/paint and create each design ready to be printed, and hand tie bows to meet customer specification ensuring each bow is the same. This enables Berisfords to offer a substantial range of themed ribbons and bows, making them the largest Ribbon Manufacturer in the UK.
